Corona Centennial Edges Host Cathedral

Centennial (Corona) 72, Cathedral 63

Sedrick Barefield scored 29 points, including 4 three-pointers, and Centennial (Corona) finished the game with a 12-0 run to get past host Cathedral in the marquee game of the Greatest Showcase On Earth Saturday night.

It was a game of runs, with Centennial (22-2) holding a lead until Cathedral went on a 10-0 run to lead, 37-30, late in the second quarter. But the Huskies went on a 10-0 run to take a 40-37 lead early in the third quarter. The lead changed hands 5 more times until Cathedral (19-3) held a narrow 63-60 lead with just over two minutes to go, but then Centennial went on its decisive 12-0 run for the win.

With Long Beach State-bound **Deontae North** out of the lineup due to a team suspension, it was up to the rest of the Huskies to take up the slack. **Kyle Hamilton** scored the first 7 points of the game for Centennial, **Marcus Ford** scored 6 points in the final 1:05 and Barefield carried the load the rest of the time as the Huskies posted their 22nd win of the season.

Hamilton helped the Huskies to an early 12-6 lead. Cathedral got back-to-back 3-pointers from **Lucas Siewert** to get within two points late in the quarter, but the Huskies pushed their lead to eight points after a 4-point play by Barefield with 3:09 left in the quarter that made it 20-12. Centennial led, 22-16, at the end of the quarter, and continued to lead into the second quarter.

With the score 30-27, Cathedral went on a 10-0 run to take a lead late in the second quarter. Back-to-back 3-pointers by **Cole Maldonado** and **Jerome Bryant**, followed by a lay-up by **Lorel Johnson** after a steal by Siewert made it 37-30, which is where things stood at the half.

Centennial began the third quarter by answering that 10-0 run with a 10-0 run of its own, helped by three baskets by Barefield and a steal & jumper by **Khalil Ahmad**. The lead went back and forth the rest of the way until Johnson gave Cathedral a 61-57 lead with a 3-pointer and a 2-point jumper with under three minutes to play.

Two free throws by **Chandler Redix** maintained Cathedral's 63-60 lead, but those would be the Phantoms' final points of the night. Ford made a 3-pointer with 1:05 left to give Centennial a lead, and scored off a pass from Ahmad on a fast break moments later to make it 67-63. Ford added a free throw and Barefield added a pair of free throws in the final 34.1 seconds to make it 70-63. Hamilton added a gratuitous uncontested dunk just ahead of the buzzer to close out the scoring.

For Centennial, Barefield led all scorers with his 29 points, and he added 4 assists and 4 steals. Ford came off the bench for 15 points, also including 4 three-pointers. Hamilton just missed a double-double with 11 points and a game-high 9 rebounds. Ahmad had 4 points, 4 rebounds, 3 assists and a game-high 6 steals.

For Cathedral, Bryant had a team-high 15 points and Siewert had 12 points, 7 rebounds, 2 assists and 3 steals. Johnson came off the bench for 12 points, and Redix came off the bench as well and had a very strong game with 9 points, 8 rebounds, 6 assists, 2 steals and a blocked shot.
